Even Count Flat Peyote with a Diagonal Stripe



Supplies:

Thread of you choice, Silamide, Nymo, Fireline

Beading needle size 10 or 12

Two colors size 5 beads of your choice. Bead size will determine time spent on this project.

A will be main color and B will be contrasting color in these instructions

- 1. Put on a stop bead leaving about 12" as a tail.
- 2. Thread 1 B bead then 7 A beads on and bring down to stop bead. These 8 beads are both row 1 & row 2.
- 3. Turn piece and add 1 A bead. Skip first bead and needle thru the second bead. Add another A bead, skip the next bead and needle thru the next bead. Add one more A bead. Skip the next bead and needle thru the next bead.



- 4. The last bead added will be a B bead.
- 5. Turn add an A bead and needle thru the next B bead.
- 6. Add 1 B bead and needle thru the next bead.
- 7. Continue in this manner. You will be adding 4 beads in each row. You will add 1 B bead in each row in the appropriate place to continue the diagonal pattern.



- 8. You can add a decorative edge by running thread along the side and adding a B bead every other row.
- 9. Add your clasp of either a button, large bead, a beaded bead or metal clasp. gen@new-bel.com www.new-bel.com
