

Single Spiral Necklace with Peyote Cuff



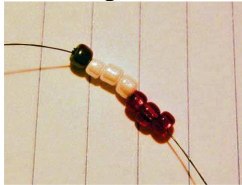
Supplies:

Two colors with good contrast of size five or six seed beads. One will be the core beads (A) the other will be the main beads (B).

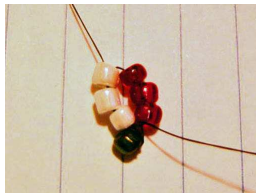
Nymo thread with thread heaven or other thread of your choice

Size 10 or 12 beading needle

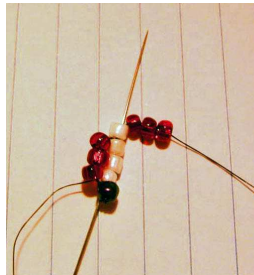
1. Cut a piece of thread 6' long or as long as it is comfortable for you to work with and thread it on the needle. Not double.
2. Put a stopper bead on by going thru a bead twice in the same direction. Leave a 10" tail for your clasp.
3. Add **3** A beads and **3** B beads and drop them down to the stopper bead.



4. Needle up thru all **6** beads in the same direction and then again but thru only the **3** A beads.

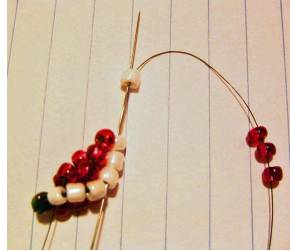


5. Push the B beads to the left and then add 1 A bead and 3 B beads and bring them down to other beads.
6. Needle up thru 4 A beads and pull thread thru. The B beads should now nestle up against the other beads.

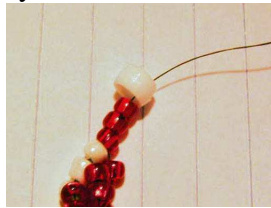
7. Again add 1 A bead and 3 B beads. This time go thru 3 old A beads and the one new A bead.



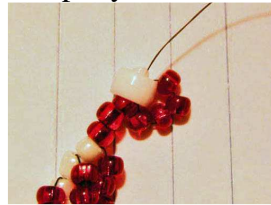
8. Continue in this manner until the piece is as long as you would like. You will be adding 1 A bead and 3 B beads each time. Each time you will go thru 3 old A beads and 1 new A beads for a total of 4 A beads each time.

A Beaded Bead Clasp

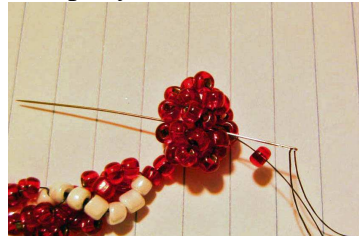
1. You will need one pony bead with a large hole and beads from your necklace either the A beads or B beads.
2. Add 3 beads and then the pony bead.



3. Add 3 beads and needle up thru the pony bead. This will add the first row of beads that will start to cover the pony bead.



4. Continue adding beads, 3 at a time, to the pony bead until entire bead is covered.
5. Add one more bead to the top of the pony bead. Don't go down thru the bead but go down thru the space in the pony bead. This will lock the beads in place.



6. When coming out the bottom of the pony bead add 3 more beads and then connect to your piece.

7. Make 2 or 3 half hitch knots and go up one side thru the pony bead and down the other side one more time. Secure thread by making 3 more half hitches down the core of the bracelet. Go thru a few more beads and cut thread.
8. Using your 10" tail make a loop with beads that will fit the beaded bead. Go thru the loop 2 or 3 times and secure with half hitches as in previous step.

Peyote Cuff

Make a strip of even count peyote starting with 8 beads. When the strip is long enough to fit around spiral necklace you will zip up the peyote strip to make a tube. Hang this from necklace. You may add fringe to the tube for a fancier necklace.
